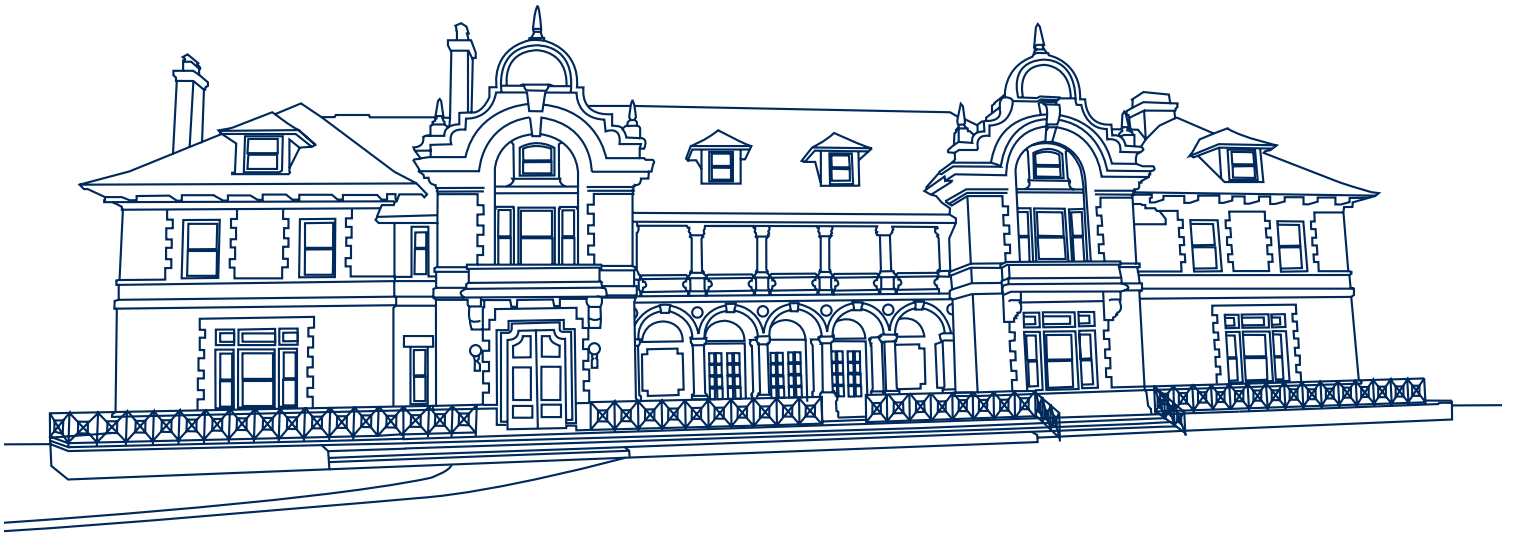

CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS:

1. Complete the Application for Admission. This application may also be submitted via the Dowling College website at www.dowling.edu.
2. Attach a non-refundable application fee of \$35 (check or money order). Please make check payable to Dowling College.
3. If you have taken any Advanced Placement examinations and/or any college courses while attending high school, please arrange for your AP scores and/or college course transcript(s) to be sent to the Office of Enrollment Services at Dowling College.
4. Include a Personal Portfolio.*
5. Include a Letter of Recommendation from a Guidance Counselor or Teacher.
6. Submit your Dowling College application to your high school guidance office. The counselor will attach your high school transcript (including SAT/ACT scores, if available), and mail the completed application to Dowling College in the envelope provided. *(Note: Transcripts for college courses taken during high school and AP scores are not included on your high school transcript and must be submitted separately, as noted in item #3 above.)*
7. If you plan on residing on campus, please complete and submit the Application for Student residence, along with a \$200 deposit.

ADULT STUDENTS AND TRANSFER STUDENTS:

1. Complete the Application for Admission. This application may also be submitted via the Dowling College website at www.dowling.edu.
2. Attach a non-refundable application fee of \$35 (check or money order). Please make check payable to Dowling College.
3. Have all AP scores and official transcripts from all previous institutions sent to the Office of Enrollment Services at Dowling College.
4. Include a Personal Portfolio.*
5. Include a Letter of Recommendation.
6. If you plan on residing on campus, please complete and submit the Application for Student residence, along with a \$200 deposit.

**A Personal Portfolio should contain an essay and/or personal statement of at least 250 words, as well as anything else that you consider relevant for your admission to Dowling College.*
